Complete these challenges to earn the title of **Kyoto Master Explorer!**

Top Secret Mission: Kyoto Adventure

Operation Temple & Shrine Seeker

- **Torii Trail** Walk through the thousands of red torii gates at Fushimi Inari Shrine.
- Bonus: Can you find a fox statue (kitsune) along the path?
- **Guardian Quest** Find the lion-dog statues (komainu) guarding the entrance of a temple.
- **Bonus**: Can you tell which one has its mouth open and which one is closed?

Operation Nature Explorer

- **Bamboo Tracker** Walk through the Arashiyama Bamboo Forest and listen to the sound of the wind.
- Bonus: How tall do you think the bamboo grows?
- Secret Waterfall Find a small waterfall or stream in a temple garden.



• **Bonus:** Watch how the water flows, is it fast, slow, or still?

Operation Samurai & Ninja

- **Samurai Stance** At Nijo Castle, find the hidden nightingale floors that chirp when stepped on.
- **Bonus:** Imagine you are a samurai on patrol, what do you hear?
- **Ninja Escape** Visit a hidden alleyway in Gion or Higashiyama and imagine how ninjas might have used it.
- **Bonus**: Can you spot a wooden Machiya-style house?

Bonus Operations

- **Matcha Treats** Try a Kyoto-style matcha sweet, like matcha ice cream or dango.
- **Bonus**: What did it taste like, bitter, sweet, or creamy?
- **Maiko Spotter** Walk through Gion and see if you can spot a real Maiko (apprentice geisha)!
- Bonus: What color was her kimono?
- **Story Creator** Write or draw a story about a hidden ninja temple in Kyoto.

Craft: Create Your Own Torii Gate Path!

Design your own Kyoto shrine entrance!

What You'll Need:

- Red and black paper or crayons
- Scissors (ask an adult for help!)
- Glue or tape
- Small sticks or cardboard

Steps:

- 1. Cut out small red torii gates from paper or draw them on cardboard.
- 2. Glue or tape them onto a background to make a pathway through a mountain or forest.
- 3. Decorate the area with foxes, stone lanterns, or cherry blossoms.
- 4. Show your family and explain where your secret path leads!



Culture Guide: What Makes Kyoto Special

- **City of Temples** Kyoto has over 2,000 temples and shrines, each with unique histories.
- **Bamboo Forest Magic** The Arashiyama Bamboo Forest is one of the most famous natural spots in Japan.
- Matcha Capital Kyoto is the best place to try real matcha tea and sweets!
- **Samurai History** The Shogun's Castle, Nijo Castle, has hidden security features like nightingale floors.
- **Fushimi Inari Shrine** This famous shrine has thousands of red torii gates and is protected by fox spirits (kitsune).

Language Guide: Speak Like a Local in Kyoto!

Learn some words from the Kyoto dialect (Kyoto-ben)!

- **Honma ni omoshiroi na!** (ほんまにおもしろいな!) That's really interesting!
- Ookini! (おおきに!) Thank you! (Used instead of "Arigatou" in Kyoto!)
- **Ee na!** (ええな!) That's nice!
- **Chotto maete!** (ちょっとまえて!) Wait a moment!

(Kyoto-ben is considered soft and elegant, locals will love hearing you try it!)

Packing Tips for Your Kyoto Adventure

Every great agent needs the right gear! Don't forget to pack these mission essentials:

- Walking shoes Kyoto's temples have lots of stairs and stone paths!
- Notebook & pencil Record discoveries in your Secret Mission Log.
- Camera or phone Capture the bamboo forest and torii gates!
- A small bag Perfect for souvenirs like lucky charms (omamori)!
- Light jacket Kyoto can be chilly in the mornings and evenings!
