Top Secret Mission: Osaka Adventure

Operation Castle & Samurai

- Osaka Castle Quest Walk through Osaka Castle Park and count how many golden decorations you can find on the castle!
- **Bonus**: Can you spot the tiger statue near the entrance?
- **Samurai Mystery** Inside Osaka Castle Museum, find a samurai helmet or sword.
- **Bonus**: Imagine you are a samurai protecting the castle, what would be your battle strategy?

Operation Food Hunter

- Takoyaki Taste Test Try Osaka's famous takoyaki (octopus balls)!
- Bonus: Can you flip a takoyaki like the street vendors do?
- **Kushikatsu Challenge** Try kushikatsu (deep-fried skewers) without double-dipping in the sauce!



• **Bonus**: What was the tastiest skewer you tried?

Operation City Explorer

- **Glico Sign Spotter** Find the famous running man sign in Dotonbori and take a picture copying his pose!
- **Bonus**: What other neon signs can you spot?
- **Kaiyukan Aquarium Adventure** Visit Osaka Aquarium Kaiyukan and find a whale shark swimming in the tank!
- Bonus: Can you find a fish with bright colors?

Bonus Operations

- **Umeda Sky Tower Climb** Ride the elevator to the Floating Garden Observatory and look over the whole city.
- Bonus: Can you count how many bridges cross the river below?
- Osaka Train Tracker Ride on the Osaka Loop Line and count how many stations have a funny-sounding name!
- **Story Creator** Write or draw a story about a ninja who sneaks through Osaka Castle at night.

Craft: Make Your Own Glico Running Man Sign!

What You'll Need:

- Paper or cardboard

- Scissors (ask an adult for help!)
- Glue or tape

Steps:

- 1. Draw a big sign like the Glico Running Man or another famous neon sign in Osaka.
- 2. Color it in bright, neon colors to match Osaka's lively atmosphere.
- 3. Cut it out and attach it to a background with other fun Osaka drawings (takoyaki, the castle, or the aquarium!).
- 4. Show your family and practice posing like the Glico Running Man!

- **Osaka Castle's History** The castle was once a stronghold of samurai warriors during battles in the 1500s!
- **Bright Lights & Fun Vibes** Dotonbori's neon signs and entertainment make it one of Japan's most exciting places!
- **The Whale Shark City** Osaka Aquarium Kaiyukan has one of the biggest tanks in the world, with giant whale sharks!
- **Japan's Bargain Shopping Hub** Osaka's Shinsekai & Kuromon Market are great places to find fun and quirky souvenirs.

Language Guide: Speak Like a Local in Osaka!

Learn some words from the Osaka dialect (Osaka-ben)!

- Meccha omoroi na! (めっちゃおもろいな!) Super fun!
- Ookini! (おおきに!) Thank you! (Used instead of "Arigatou" in Osaka!)
- **Bochi bochi da na!** (ぼちぼちだな!) It's going alright!
- Nan de ya nen! (なんでやねん!) No way!/Are you serious?!

(Osaka-ben is fun and energetic, locals will love hearing you try it!)
