Craft: Disney Character Masks

Create your own Disney mask to wear on your visit!

What you'll need:

- Paper plates or cardstock
- Markers, crayons, or paint
- Scissors
- Elastic string or ribbon
- Glue or tape
- Decorations: stickers, glitter, colored paper

Steps:

1. **Choose a character:** Decide which Disney character you want to create (Mickey, Minnie, Donald, or others).
2. **Shape the Mask:** Cut out eye holes in your paper plate or cardstock. For ears (like Mickey or Minnie), cut and glue extra circles on top.
