Operation City Explorer

1. Tower Climber – Climb all the way up the Miguelete Tower at Valencia Cathedral. Count the steps as you go! Bonus: Can you spot the beach from the top?
2. Market Detective – Search for the juiciest orange or the coolest pastry at Mercado Central. Snap a picture or write down your favorite!

Operation Park Adventurer

1. Gulliver's Explorer – Slide down Gulliver's hair or arms at Gulliver Park. Bonus: Find the highest point you can climb!
2. Nature Guardian – Spot 3 different kinds of trees or flowers in Turia Gardens. Write down their colors or draw them!

Operation Wildlife Watcher

1. Safari Tracker – At Bioparc Valencia, find an animal that swings, one that splashes, and one that sleeps! Bonus: Which animal was the funniest?
2. Ocean Detective – Walk through the shark tunnel at Oceanographic Valencia. Count how many sharks you see swimming above you!

Bonus Operations

1. Beach Guardian – At the playa (beach), build a sandcastle with towers and a moat. Take a picture to prove your skills!
2. Light Detective – If it's December, find the most colorful Christmas lights in the city. Bonus: Can you find lights shaped like stars?
3. Story Creator – Write or draw a story about a lion at Bioparc who dreams of becoming a scientist at the City of Arts and Sciences.

Craft: Gulliver's Dream Playground

What you'll need:

- Paper
- Markers or crayons
- Scissors (ask an adult for help!)
- Glue or tape

Steps:

1. Draw Gulliver lying down (like the one at Gulliver Park). Make sure to include his hair, arms, and legs!
2. Cut out little slides, ladders, and ramps from paper.
3. Tape or glue your slides and ladders to Gulliver to design your own playground!
4. Show off your playground design to your family and ask what they'd want to climb first.

Culture Guide: What Makes Valencia Special

- Paella Paradise: Valencia is the birthplace of paella! Traditional paella has chicken and rabbit, but seafood versions are also popular.
- Las Fallas: In March, Valencia celebrates with fireworks, parades, and huge sculptures called Ninots. At the end, they burn the sculptures in a big bonfire!
- City of Innovation: Valencia is famous for its futuristic architecture, especially at the City of Arts and Sciences.
- The Torres de Serranos: Step back in time at the Torres de Serranos, ancient towers that once guarded Valencia's city gates. Kids can climb to the top and imagine being medieval knights while enjoying amazing views of the city!
- La Lonja de la Seda: This "Silk Exchange" building looks like a castle! It's a UNESCO World Heritage Site where kids can spot gargoyles and explore the grand hall where merchants traded silk long ago.

Language Guide: Speak Like a Valencian

Here are some handy phrases in Valencian (a dialect of Catalan) to try on your adventure:

- Hola! (OH-lah): Hello!
- Gràcies! (GRAH-syehs): Thank you!
- On està...? (Ohn es-TAH): Where is...?
- Adéu! (ah-DEH-oo): Goodbye!

Valencian is widely spoken alongside Spanish, and locals will appreciate your effort to use their language!
