Top Secret Mission: Yokohama Adventure

Operation Skyline & Harbor Explorer

- Cosmo Clock Countdown Ride the Cosmo Clock 21 Ferris wheel and count how many boats you can see from the top!
- **Bonus**: Can you find a red brick building from up high?
- **Sailor's Secret** Visit the Nippon Maru sailing ship and look for the big anchor.
- Bonus: Imagine you're the captain, where would you sail first?

Operation Chinatown Treasure Hunt

- **Dragon Spotter** Walk through Yokohama Chinatown and find a golden dragon decoration.
- **Bonus**: Can you count how many red lanterns are hanging in the street?
- Soup Dumpling Challenge Try a soup dumpling (xiao long bao) from Chinatown!



Bonus: What did the dumpling taste like, savory, sweet, or spicy?

Operation Park & Nature Explorer

- Sankeien Garden Mystery Find a hidden pagoda in Sankeien Garden.
- **Bonus**: What color are the koi fish in the pond?
- Yokohama Beach Mission Visit Yamashita Park and find a ship statue or anchor near the bay.
- Bonus: How many seagulls can you count?

Bonus Operations

- Red Brick Warehouse Quest Find an old clock at the Red Brick Warehouse shopping area.
- **Bonus**: What was the coolest shop or café inside?
- Yokohama Landmark Hunt Spot Yokohama Landmark Tower, the tallest building in the city!
- Bonus: Can you see Mt. Fuji on a clear day?
- **Story Creator** Write or draw a story about a pirate ship sailing into Yokohama Bay!

Craft: Make Your Own Chinatown Lantern!

Create your own Yokohama-style festival lantern!

What You'll Need:

- Red paper or crayons
- Scissors (ask an adult for help!)
- Glue or tape
- String or ribbon

Steps:

- 1. Fold a piece of paper in half and cut slits along the fold.
- 2. Unfold the paper and roll it into a cylinder shape.
- 3. Glue or tape the ends together and attach a string at the top.
- 4. Decorate it with gold dragons or Chinese characters!
- 5. Hang it up and let it glow in your next adventure!



Culture Guide: What Makes Yokohama Special

- **Japan's First International Port** Yokohama was the first city in Japan to open to foreign trade in 1859!
- **The Ferris Wheel with a Clock** The Cosmo Clock 21 was once the biggest Ferris wheel in the world!
- **The Largest Chinatown in Japan** Yokohama Chinatown is filled with amazing food and colorful festivals.
- **Yamashita Park's History** This park was built after the Great Kanto Earthquake and has a beautiful oceanfront view.
- **Sankeien Garden's Hidden Pagoda** This historic pagoda was moved from Kyoto and hidden in the garden!

Language Guide: Speak Like a Local in Yokohama!

Even though Yokohama doesn't have a strong dialect, locals use friendly and easygoing expressions every day.

- Sugoi ne! (すごいね!) That's amazing!
- Umaii! (うまい!) Delicious! (Casual way to say "yummy!")
- **Ii ne!** (いいね!) That's great!
- Nani sore?! (なにそれ?!) What's that?! (Playfully surprised)
